### **GALATIANS 5:16-24**

<sup>16</sup>I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

<sup>17</sup>For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

<sup>18</sup>But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

<sup>19</sup>Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness,

<sup>20</sup>idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies,

<sup>21</sup>envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

<sup>22</sup>But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

<sup>23</sup>gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

<sup>24</sup>And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

### **LUKE 17:11-19**

<sup>11</sup>Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee.

<sup>12</sup>Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off.

<sup>13</sup>And they lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"

<sup>14</sup>So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed.

<sup>15</sup>And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God,

<sup>16</sup>and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan.

<sup>17</sup>So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine?"

<sup>18</sup>Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?"

<sup>19</sup>And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."
