

#### 1 JOHN 4:1-6

- <sup>1</sup> Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.
- <sup>2</sup> By this you know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God,
- <sup>3</sup> and every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not of God. And this is the spirit of the Antichrist, which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world.

- <sup>4</sup> You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.
- <sup>5</sup> They are of the world. Therefore they speak as of the world, and the world hears them.
- <sup>6</sup> We are of God. He who knows God hears us; he who is not of God does not hear us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error.

#### **LUKE 22:66-23:3**

- <sup>66</sup> As soon as it was day, the elders of the people, both chief priests and scribes, came together and led Him into their council, saying,
- <sup>67</sup> "If You are the Christ, tell us." But He said to them, "If I tell you, you will by no means believe.
- <sup>68</sup> And if I also ask you, you will by no means answer Me or let Me go.
- <sup>69</sup> Hereafter the Son of Man will sit on the right hand of the power of God."
- <sup>70</sup> Then they all said, "Are You then the Son of God?" So He said to them, "You rightly say that I am."

- <sup>3</sup> Then Pilate asked Him, saying, "Are You the King of the Jews?" He answered him and said, "It is as you say."
